## **Guidelines for Competitors:**

- i. Exhibits judged on interpretation of schedule, creativity, originality, principles and elements of design.
- ii. Plant material should predominate over all other components in a design.
- iii. Exhibits must be the individual exhibitors own work.
- iv. No artificial plant material may be used (e.g., manufactured or artificial flowers/foilage)
- v. Fresh plant material must be in water or water retaining material that does not alter the effect of the arrangement.
- vi. Any embellishments and/or props allowed unless specified otherwise.
- vii. A design must not be changed in any way after it is judged.
- viii. One entry per exhibitor per class
- ix. The judge's decision is final

<b><i>COLLECTION</i></b>	More than one variety (minimum 5 cuts)
<b><i>NND</i></b>	Not necessarily distinct
<b><i>AOV</i></b>	Any Other Variety
<b><i>AV</i></b>	Any Variety
<b><i>ROSE SECTION</i></b>	Roses and Rose foliage only
